Principal's Message

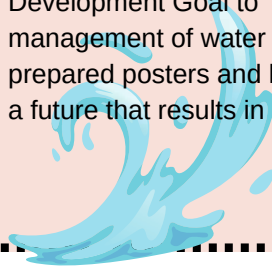


Chère communauté de Keystone!

EXAM WEEK

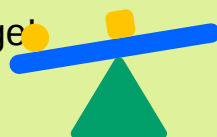
